

Tisca Forte Tiles is available in four designs: Lily, River, Oriental, and Flowers.




Well-known designs, reinterpreted, give spaces a unique character and at the same time form a supporting foundation for the individuality of a room's style.







### Advantages of EVA Backing

Since the backing of carpet tiles has to be designed to be significantly heavier than rolls of carpet, the greatest attention must be paid to the environmental footprint, which means backing designs need to be selected that support environmental sustainability.

Consumers are right to demand that interior design products be made from environmentally friendly materials.

### EVA is a particularly high-quality tile backing with functional and environmental advantages:

- High elasticity and flexibility
- · Extremely pliable
- Excellent impact resistance
- High resistance to stress cracking
- · Chemically stable
- Excellent weather resistance
- Easy to transport and work with
- · High dimensional stability
- Perfect in combination with roll goods

## What makes Tisca Forte tiles so special?

#### Easy to install

The carpet tiles are extremely easy to lay and can be replaced just as easily. The woven velour results in extremely clean joints, and the tiles can be laid together in any orientation. The high-quality EVA coating makes them highly flexible and dimensionally stable.

#### Enhances any space

Tisca Forte tiles absorb noise, are comfortable to walk on, and are also suitable for high-traffic areas in public buildings or restaurants.

#### Easy to maintain

Tisca Forte is dirt-repellent and resistant to stains. The tiles can be cleaned with disinfecting cleaning agents, and it is even easy to remove stubborn stains.

#### Long-lasting and durable

The fibers are dyed during the manufacturing process and are therefore dyed completely through, just like a carrot. The solution-dyed fibers withstand the highest levels of mechanical stress and are extremely durable and lightfast.

#### Sustainability

Tisca Forte is woven from regenerated thread obtained from post-consumer and post-industrial polyamide 6 waste materials. Through a special regeneration process, these materials, which are at the end of their life cycle, are transformed back into top-quality polyamide without any loss of quality.

One particularly ingenious aspect of the process is that it does not result in a loss of quality, as can happen during recycling. This regeneration process maintains the original product's level of quality, thereby ensuring an endless cycle.


